Pedestrian Fatal

ABILENE, TX – On Saturday, January 23, 2021, at 10:15 p.m. officers of the Abilene Police Department's Patrol and Traffic Divisions responded to South First and Morris Streets to a vehicle collision involving a pedestrian. The initial investigation revealed that a Silver Mitsubishi Galant driven by Clark Lee Hill Jr. of Abilene struck a White male pedestrian that was in the inside east bound lane.

The pedestrian, whose name is being withheld pending notification of next of kin, was pronounced deceased at the scene by Justice of the Peace Frank Cleveland. Although it is unknown if alcohol was a factor in this collision, blood specimens were obtained from both the driver and the pedestrian. Attempt has been made to notify next of kin of the deceased and at this time notification has been unsuccessful. This collision remains under investigation by the Abilene Police Department's Traffic Division.
