ART

FISHERMAN'S BOAT

Give each child a half of a Styrofoam hamburger carton, a triangular sail, 1 8-inch drinking straw, and a small blob of clay. Help them scotch tape the sail to the straw. Put the clay in the center of the carton and stick the straw into the clay.

PASTA ANGELS

Use a dried lima bean for head. For curls, brush glue on one side of the bean and press it into a pile of tiny soup pastas. Use markers to draw on a face. Use a rigatoni noodle for the body. Glue on a wagon-wheel pasta collar, elbow-macaroni arms, and boy=tie pasta wings. Glue the head onto the body. For hanger, tie on a loop of thread below the bean.

CLOTHESPIN ANGELS

Materials: Paper plate Milk cap Yellow construction paper Roll of masking tape blue flat 4-inch wooden spoon clothespin

Cut the paper plate into eight wedges and trim off the point of each wedge. For the halo, trace around a milk cap on yellow construction paper. For the wings, trace around a roll of masking tape on yellow construction paper and cut the resulting circle in half. Glue the halo onto the large end of the spoon and the wings onto the back of one of the paper plate wedges. Glue the angel's body onto the spoon, then glue the angel onto a clothespin. Clip the angel to almost anything.

STAINED GLASS CROSS



Materials: Wax paper, crayon shavings, iron, construction paper, glue, scissors

Fold a piece of Black construction paper and cut a cross shape out of the center.

Put crayon shavings between 2 pieces of waxed paper.

Iron the paper with a warm iron so the shavings melt.

Glue the waxed paper to the back of the black construction paper so the colors show through the cross-shaped hole.

OTHER FUN STUFF

THE LOST SHEEP GAME

This works well with groups of 10 or more and children at least 5 years old. One child leaves the room and hides his eyes. Choose another child to leave the room and go where they cannot be seen. The remaining children can stay in place, or to make it harder, they move around. The original person comes back in the room and tries to figure out who is missing. You can give clues if they cannot figure it out. After you finish, talk about how God knows where we are at all times and can always find us.

THE GOOD SAMARITAN

Let the children put real band-aids (the tiny ones) on a figure of a person and talk about what ways even children can help people.

THE LOST COIN

Make a fairly good-sized coin out of cardboard (6 inches, maybe) and hide and find it all morning over and over again! Make a paper pouch for vanilla wafer *coins* to take home!

PRODIGAL SON

Plan a little celebration party! Add a few balloons to bounce around and some streamers! Parties are ALWAYS fun!

THE FISH & BREAD

Make a paper basket with crumpled paper bags. Fill with oyster crackers (the bread) and fish crackers.

JESUS HELPS HIS FRIENDS CATCH FISH!

Make small paper fish and attach a paper clip to each one. Put in a big box or basket and let children take turns (or have a couple poles so several can fish at once) *catching* fish with a short stick to which a string has been tied, with a small magnet tied as a hook.

BUILDING

S-O-O-O BIG

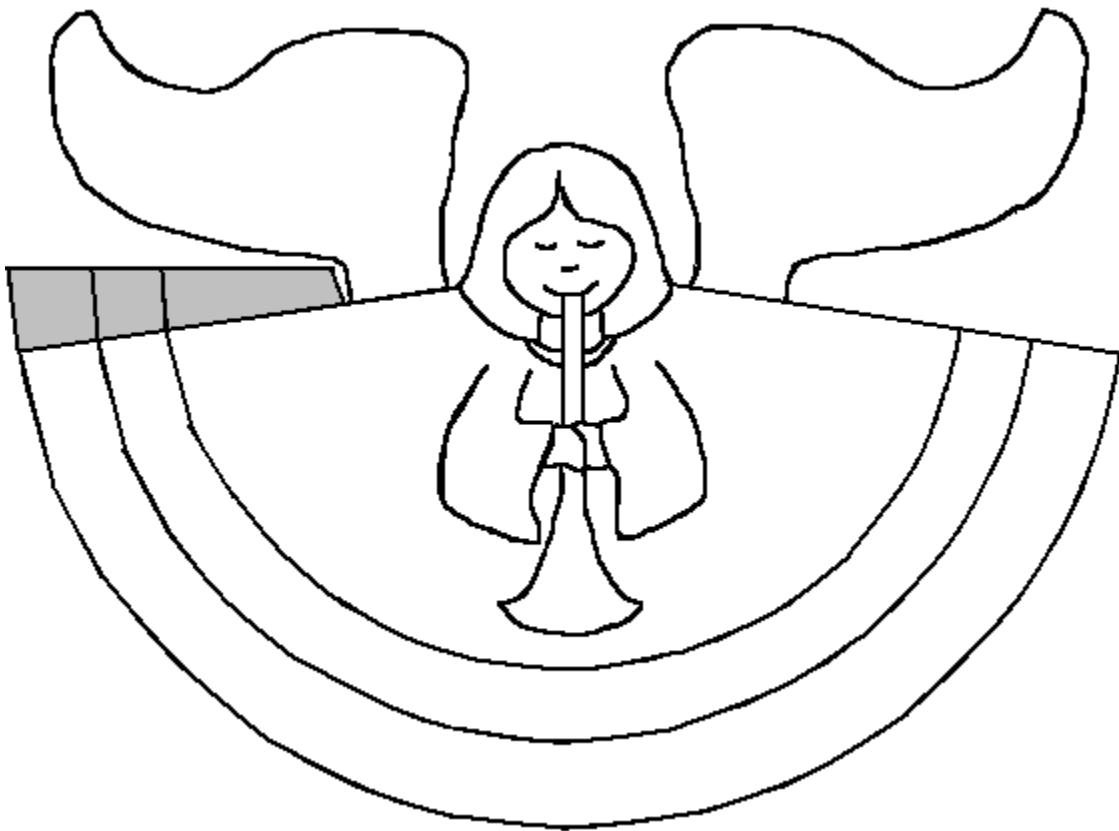
How big is God's world? So-o-o-o big (hold arms outstretched)
