

# WEATHER

## ART

### SNOWMAN PIN

Materials: glue  
White poster paint  
salt  
black and orange craft paper  
red yarn  
safety pin  
peanut

Mix a few drops of glue into the paint. Paint the peanut. While still wet, sprinkle with salt. Lean against a pencil to dry. Cut hat, eyes, and buttons from black paper. Cut a carrot nose from orange paper, Glue to snowman. Cut 5" piece of red yarn. Tie around peanut for scarf. Secure with glue. Slip the back of the safety pin through the scarf.

### EGG CARTON SNOWMAN

1. Cut a three cup section from the egg carton and glue or tape it to a background piece of construction paper.
2. Cut out a top hat, buttons, and black boots for snowman from black construction paper and glue them in place.
3. Cut out mittens, a scarf, and nose and glue them on.
4. Add facial features with marker.
5. Glue cotton ball snow around the bottom of picture and add falling snow above.

### JAR SNOWMAN

Materials: large plastic jar with lid  
Fiberfill  
4 buttons  
2 twigs  
orange felt  
red pompom

Clean and dry jar. fill with fiberfill. slip 2 buttons between the side of the jar and the fiberfill for the snowman's buttons. Cut a nose from orange felt and slip it in place. Put two more buttons above the nose for the eyes. Slip a twig into each side of the jar for the arms. Put pompom on top of lid.

## ICICLES

Mix white glitter into a container of white paint. Hang a piece of dark construction paper on an easel. Let child brush a line of paint across top of paper and watch as paint drips down to make sparkly icicles.

## SNOW PICTURES

Mix equal amounts of salt and flour. Pour into a container with a shaker top. Give child piece of dark construction paper and let them paint on it with water. Have child place wet paper in plastic dishpan and sprinkle it with salt/flour mixture. Help child shake off excess mixture from their painting. Set Snow Picture out to dry.

## FROSTY FRIENDS

Create this frosty friend according to these directions, and a snowstorm will appear right before your eyes. To begin, cut out and glue two or three white paper circles to a sheet of blue construction paper. Using permanent markers, transform the circles into a snowy friend by adding facial features and clothing. When the picture is done, brush over it with a heavily saturated mixture of salt and water. Set the picture aside to dry where you can watch the transformation. It's a snowstorm!

## BLUE SKIES AND COTTON BALLS



Take a large blue piece of construction paper and add clumps of white fluffy cotton balls to it with glue to create cotton clouds. Add a bright shining sun in the sky! (encourage kids to create cloud formations.)

## WIND SOCKS

Materials: Paper  
Markers  
Stapler  
Streamers (three 10" strips per child)  
Ribbon (10" per child)



1. Have children to decorate their papers using markers
2. Roll each paper into a cylinder and staple it
3. Attach the streamers to the bottom of the cylinder
4. Attach a ribbon to the top for hanging

## **PAPER PLATE SNOWMEN**

Staple 3 paper plates together to form a snowman. Decorate with scraps of crepe paper, buttons, and felt.

## **SNOWFLAKES**

Glue 'honeycomb' cereal to blue paper.

## **RAIN PICTURES**

Tint small containers of glue with blue food coloring. Have children draw a picture and then dot over picture with toothpicks and glue, creating a falling rain scene.

## **WIND CHIMES**

Use nails tied to strings to make chimes.

## **THUNDERSTORMS:**

Start by gluing cotton to the top of your paper, for clouds. Cut silver rick-rack into pieces about one and half to 2" long. Glue them on, under the clouds, for lightening.

## **RAIN PAINTING**

Paint green on the bottom of the paper. (for the grass) Use a paintbrush dipped in blue paint and "Splat" it over the paper. (You can also tap the brush on a ruler to make the paint splatter on the paper)

## **SUN VISORS**

Cut a paper plate in half. Poke hole on either side and tie on elastic or yarn. Decorate with pictures of clouds or sunshine.

Oh, the snow is falling, falling through the sky.

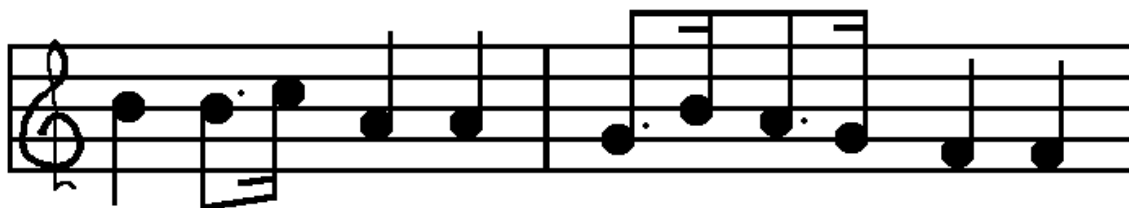
**SLEDDER'S SONG** (to tune of "If You're Happy and You Know It")

## **OTHER FUN STUFF**

### **CLOUD IN A JAR**

Find a clear glass half-gallon or gallon bottle and a cork or rubber stopper that fits in its mouth. Poke a hole vertically through the stopper. Rinse the bottle with warm water and immediately insert the stopper. Blow as much air as possible into the bottle through the hole in the stopper. Cover the hole with a finger. Pull the stopper out quickly and let the children watch as a cloud forms inside the bottle. The cloud forms because there was a change from high air pressure (when the bottle was filled with air) to low air pressure (when the stopper was removed.)

## **MAKE RAIN**

Boil water in medium pan until steam forms. Then fill pie pan with ice cubes and hold it above the pot. When the steam comes in contact with cool air from pie pan, drops of water form and fall back into pot like rain (close supervision required.)

## **AUTUMN BREEZES**

Talk about breezes. How do they feel, what do they do. Give each child a feather and a sheet of construction paper. Have them fold the paper in half. Have children stand up, drop feathers and create a breeze by waving their papers. Try to keep feather up in air. Try different objects and experiment. Cotton balls, balloons, tissues, cups, and more are great to experiment with.

## **RAIN STICKS**

Supplies:  
Cardboard rolls  
1 1/2 inch nails  
dried beans  
Masking tape

Cover end of cardboard roll with masking tape. Poke in 1 1/2 inch nails randomly all over tube so that they go all the way into the tube but not out the other side. You'll need to use quite a few to get a good sound effect. Pour in 1/2 cup dried beans. Tape up other end.

## **TORNADO DRILL**

Provide a large box to simulate a cellar, storm shelter, or closet. Practice tornado drill.

## **FROSTY WINDOWS**

Add some liquid detergent to blue and white tempera paint to make it easier to wash off. Let kids paint window with the paint. While the paint is still wet, lay sheets of plastic wrap on it, patting the plastic into place. The next day, peel off the plastic wrap to reveal the "frosty" windows.

## **INDOOR SNOWBALL TOSS**

In an indoor play area, set out cotton balls or white pom-poms on a large bed sheet. Have children toss them until all are on floor.



## **SNOWBALL FIGHT**

Divide the kids up into two teams and divide the playing area in half. Give each team a certain amount of snowballs (White socks rolled up into a ball.) On the word go the teams throw the "snowballs" across to the other team's side. After about one minute stop the play and see which team has the least amount of snowballs on their side of the room. That team is the winner.

## **LET'S SKI**

Find an old pair of shoes a little larger than the children's feet. Glue the shoes to 2 narrow strips of heavy cardboard. When the glue is dry, let the kids take turns slipping their feet into the shoes and "skiing" across a smooth-surfaced floor.

## **SNOWBALL COUNT**

Use large index cards. Draw 1 dot on first, 2 on second, etc. up to 5 dots. Count out 15 cotton balls for snowballs. Let the children put the snowballs on the dots to match the numbers.

# **GAMES**

## **SNOWBALL HUNT**

Hide cotton balls around room and let children find them.

## **AIM AND TOSS**

Stack up a pyramid of paper cups and let kids toss Styrofoam balls (snowballs) at them

## **HIDING HAT**

Place 5 – 10 small items or toys on a tray. Show the kids the tray and a "hiding hat" (winter stocking cap.) Have them look closely at the items. Ask them to cover their eyes while you place the hiding hat over one of the items. When they open their eyes, have them guess which item the hat is hiding. Take turns hiding things.

## **FROSTBITE**

Material: 1 pair of mittens for each child, cd player, candy bar.

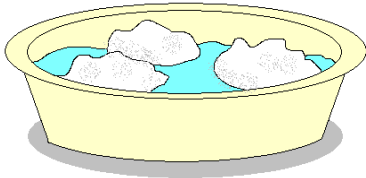
Have kids sit in circle. Each kid should have on a pair of mittens. Start music. While music plays, kids pass the candy bar around the circle. Stop music. The child holding the candy bar must try to unwrap it with the mittens on.

## CLOUD RACES

Put cotton balls on table and have kids blow them around with a straw.

## SNACKS

### PUDDING CLOUDS



½ c. blue tinted vanilla pudding  
Whipped topping

Put blue pudding into individual bowls. Let children spoon in clouds of whipped topping.

### SNOW BALLS

¾ C. marshmallow cream  
3 oz semi-sweet chocolate chips  
2 C. peanut butter  
Shredded Coconut

Mix marshmallow cream, chocolate chips, and peanut butter together and roll into small balls. Roll balls in coconut, refrigerate.

## FINGERPLAYS

### I HEAR THUNDER

I hear thunder! It's no wonder (Clap on "thunder", then put hands on ears)  
All that rain keeps coming down! (Make "rain" come down)  
Is the weather any better (Put finger on chin, wondering)  
On the other side of town (Point to "other side")

### FIVE LITTLE SNOWMEN

(hold up five fingers and wiggle them as rhyme indicates)

5 little snowmen happy & gay  
The 1st one said, "What a nice day!"  
The 2nd one said, "We'll cry no tears."  
The 3rd one said, "We'll stay for years."  
The 4th one said, "But what happens in May?"  
The 5th one said, "Look! We're melting away!"

## **THE BIG ROUND SUN**

The big round sun in a springtime sky (form large circle with arms)  
Winked at a cloud that was passing by. (wink eye)

The little cloud laughed as it scattered rain, (flutter fingers downward)  
Then out came the big round sun again (form large circle with arms)

## **CLOUD**

What's fluffy white and floats up high  
Like a pile of cotton in the sky? (point upward)  
And when the wind blows hard and strong,  
What very gently floats along? (wave hands up and down)  
What brings the rain? What brings the snow?  
That showers down on us below? (flutter fingers downward)  
When you look up in the high blue sky,  
What is that thing you see float by? (look upward and say, "A cloud!")

## **10 LITTLE SNOWMEN**

10 little snowmen riding on my sled. (hold up 10 fingers)

## GROUNDHOG DAY PUPPET

Fold a 9" x 12" white paper in half widthwise.

Unfold. Cut a 1" slit in center of fold.

Fold the paper again on same fold.

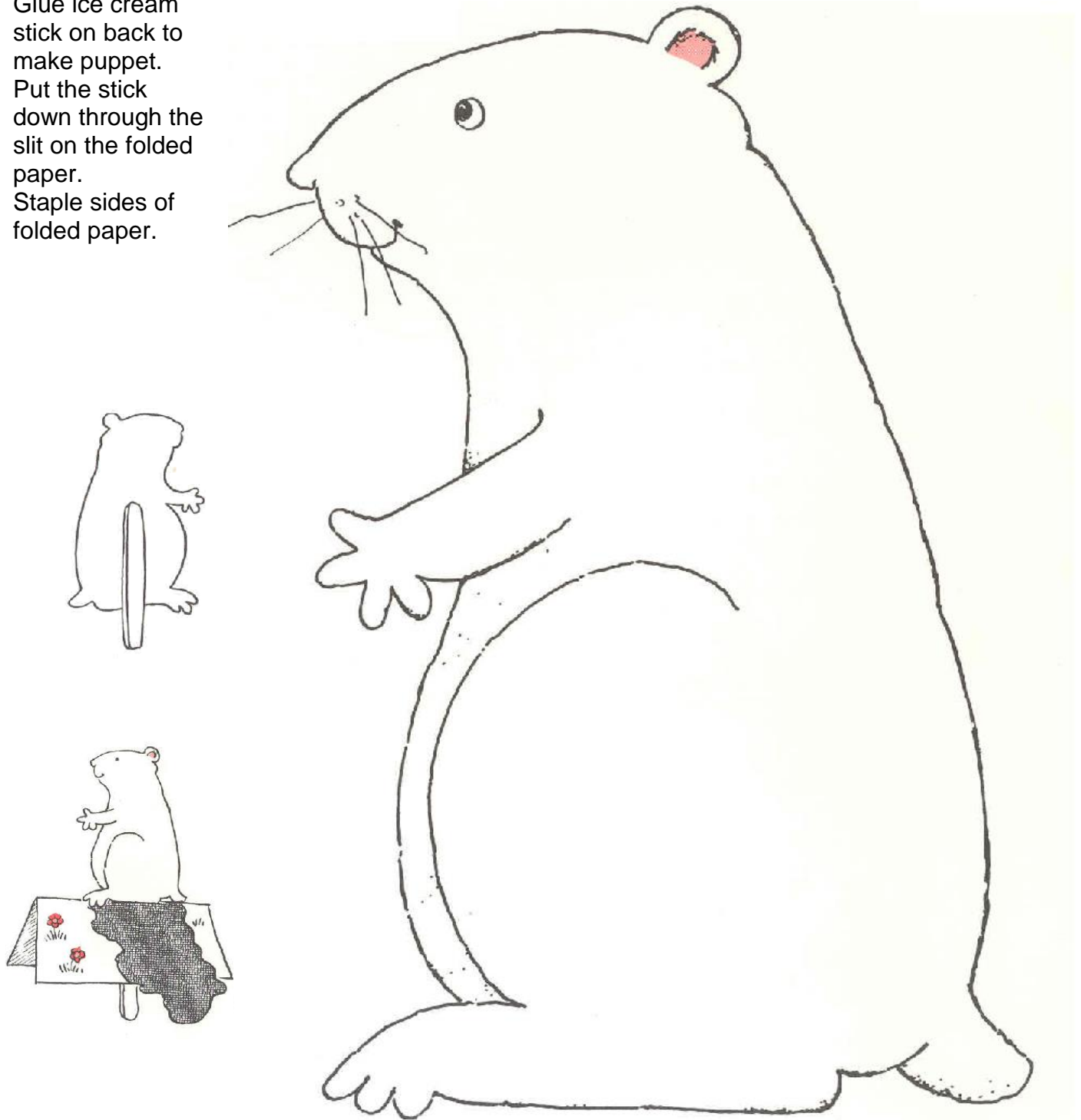
Rip a shadow shape about the size of the pattern from construction paper. Glue shadow shape to front of folded paper. Draw grass and flowers.

Reproduce groundhog onto brown paper and cut out.

Glue ice cream stick on back to make puppet.

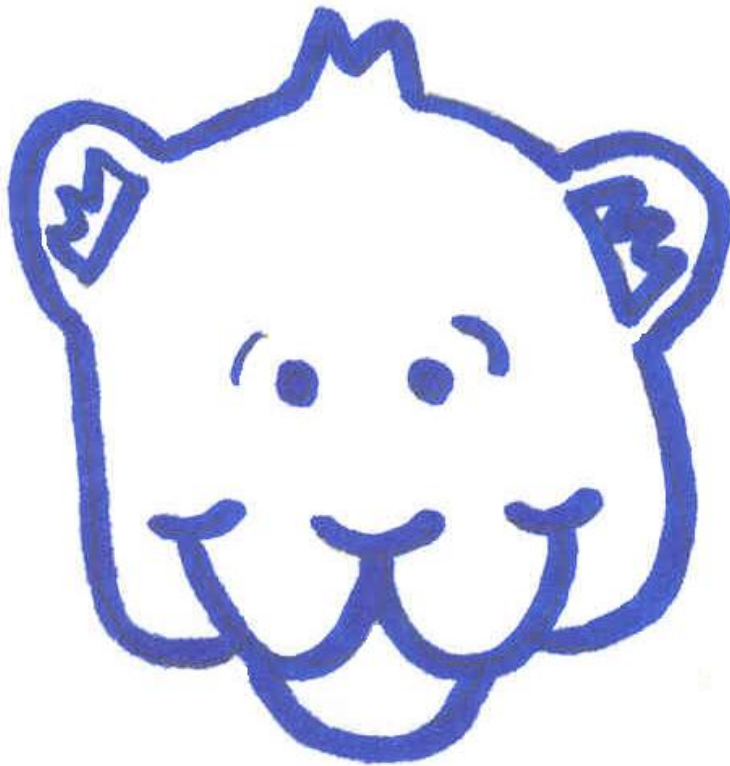
Put the stick down through the slit on the folded paper.

Staple sides of folded paper.



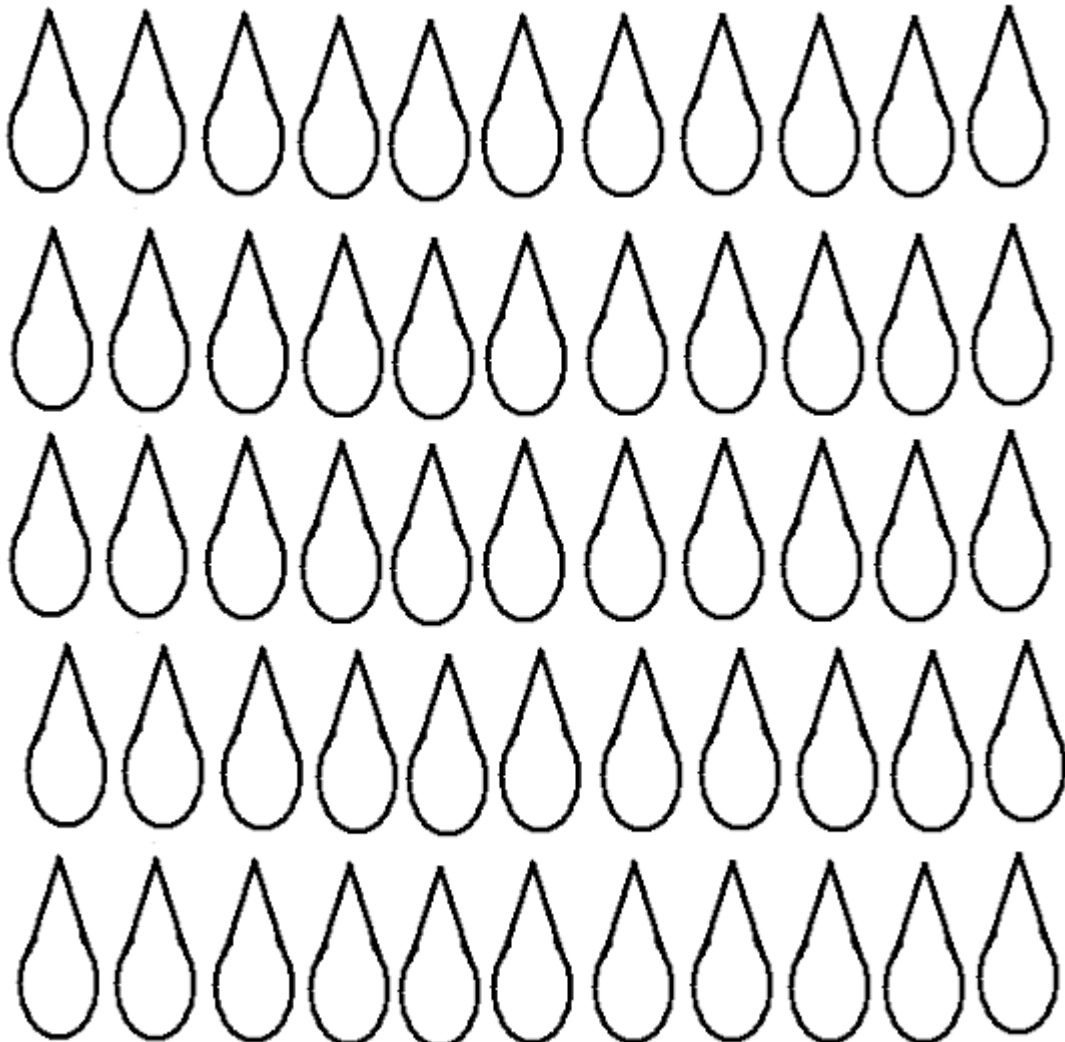
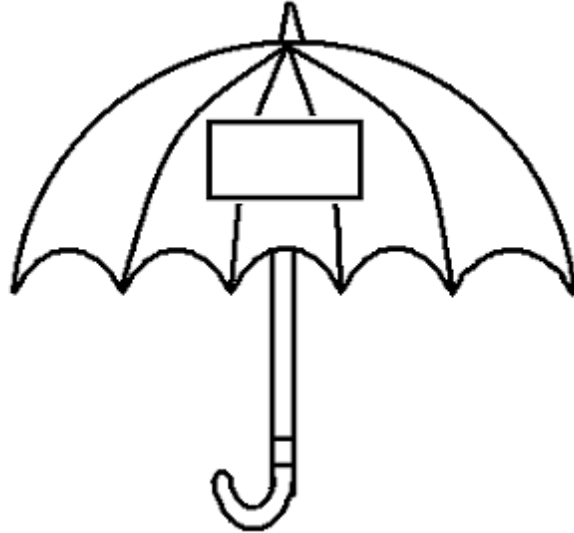
## GROUNDHOG DAY PUPPETS

Cut one face for each child and let them color. Glue face to top of craft stick. Use a butter tub or paper bowl for hole. Glue cotton balls around outside for snow. Cut slot in bottom for craft stick. Push groundhog up and down out of hole to see if he can see his shadow!



## COUNTING RAINDROPS

Duplicate umbrella 10 times onto posterboard and cut out. Number them 1-10  
Duplicate raindrops and cut out. Have children place appropriate number of raindrops around each umbrella.



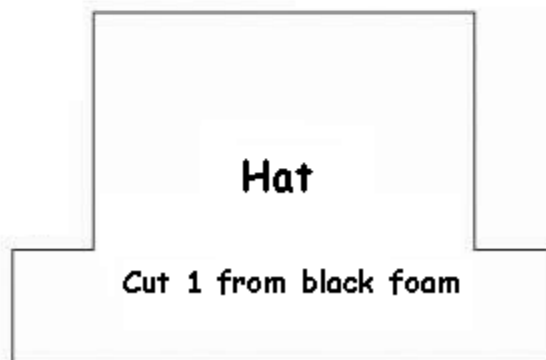
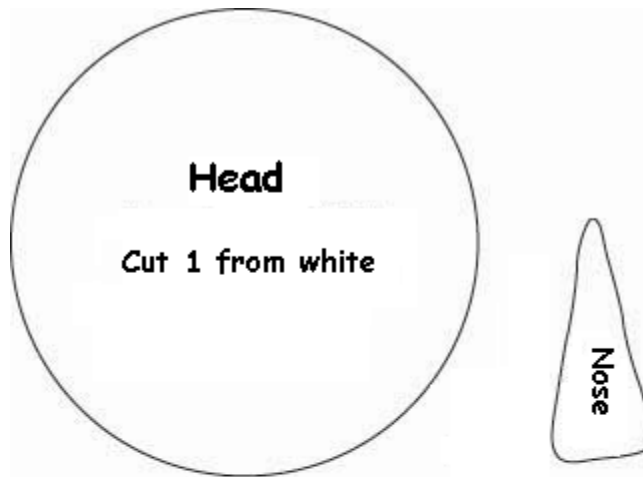
## CHIP LID SNOWMAN



Materials: 3" plastic potato chip lid, Thick craft glue, Paper, pencil, scissors, ruler, Felt: white, orange, 2½" x 3¾" piece of black craft foam, Two 5/8" black buttons, ½" red button, Six #2 black snaps, 15" length of 3/8" green ribbon, 2 5/8" length of 3/8" green and red striped ribbon, 10" length of silver baby rickrack, 1" metal snowflake

Trace and cut out patterns.

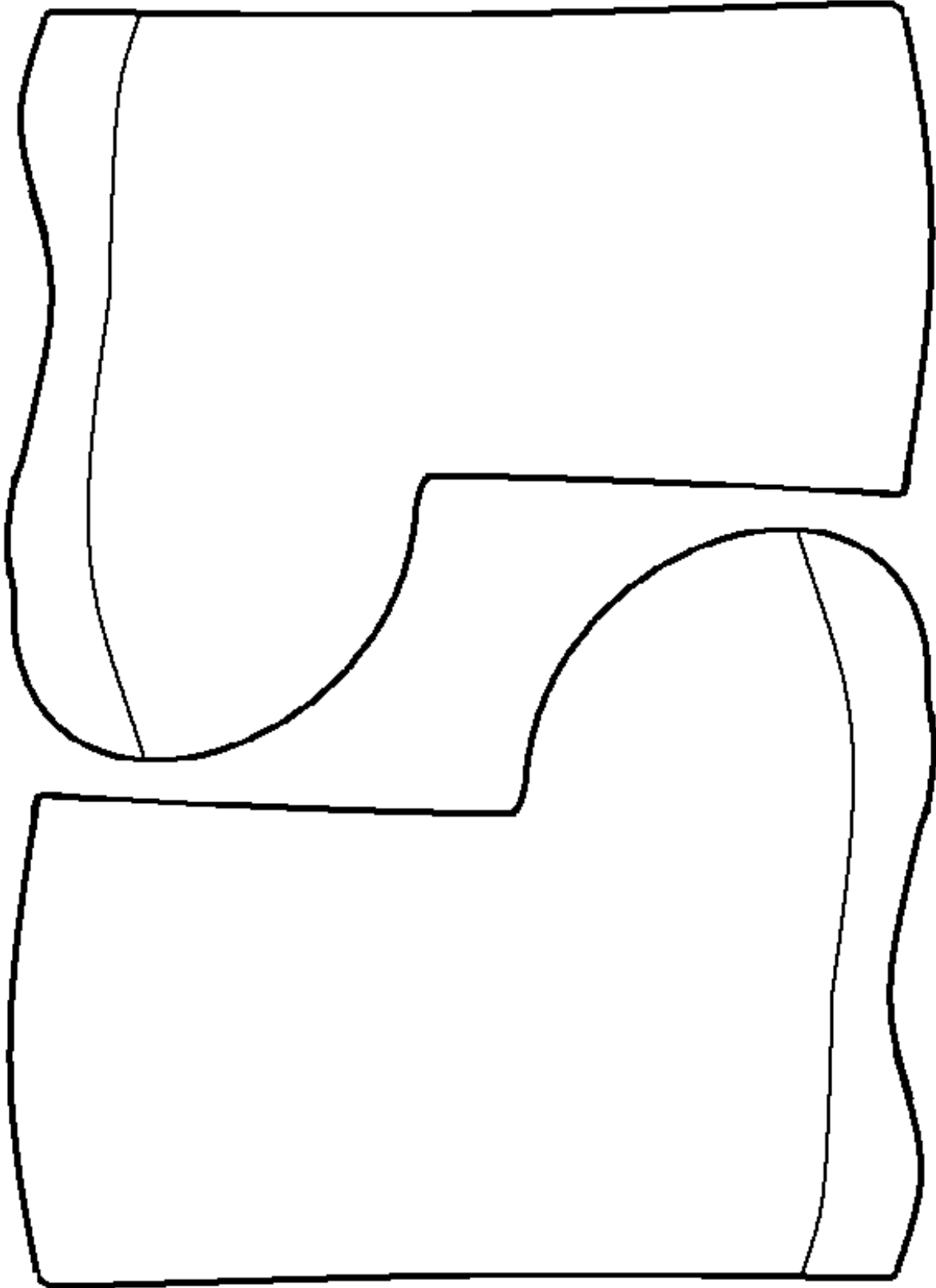
From white felt cut a 3/8" x 10½" strip. Glue strip around edge of lid. Glue head on top of lid. See photo. Glue hat on top of head. For hat band, glue green and red striped ribbon on hat as shown. Glue snowflake on hat band at right edge of hat. For eyes, glue black buttons on head. Glue nose on head. Separate snaps. (Note: Save top of snap for another project or discard.) Glue bottom of snaps on head for mouth. Tie red plaid ribbon into a 3" wide bow; cut ribbon ends in a "V". Glue bow on center bottom of head. Glue green button on center of bow. For hanging loop, glue ends of rickrack together on back center top of lid. Let dry





## PERFECT MATCH

Make 4 copies of the galoshes pattern. Label one boot in each pair with an uppercase letter and the other with the lowercase letter. Cut out the boots. Also label each of 4 puddle cutouts with the corresponding letters. Let kids match the boots to the puddles.
