SMILING PICTURES

Give child 6 x 4 inch picture of smiling lips cut out of red construction paper and 8 x 2 inch strip of white paper. Have child snip off little pieces of his paper to make teeth. Glue teeth onto paper.

TEETH COLLAGE

Make a "good food" for their teeth collage out of pictures from magazines. They might even want to hang them on their own refrigerator to remind them which foods are healthy.

OTHER ART IDEAS

Paint with old toothbrushes.

Finger paint with toothpaste (the gel kind works the best)

Make a tooth necklace using white clay and dental floss.

Design a new toothpaste brand and tube.

Draw pictures of what you think the tooth fairy looks like

Make a tooth fairy: Place a tissue over a lollipop and tie a bow under the "chin." Use a small doily for the wings.

TOOTHBRUSH HOLDERS

Take old film canisters and cut an "x" into the lids using a sharp blade (adults only!) Let kids decorate the canisters with stickers. Put toothbrush bristle-first into canister and slip lid over the handle. Slide handle down to seal holder.

OTHER FUN STUFF

BRUSHING A BIG TOOTH

Laminate a piece of white poster board. Cut into tooth shape. Let kids draw on the tooth with WASHABLE markers. Let them then brush off the mess with clean, dampened toothbrushes. You can also use dry-erase markers and a dry toothbrush.

BRUSHING THE ALLIGATOR'S TEETH

materials needed: Cardboard egg carton - one per child

Old toothbrushes White and black paint

Toothpaste (optional)

Turn egg carton upside down. The egg cups are the alligator's teeth.
Using the white paint and toothbrush, have the children brush the teeth. You can mix a small amount of toothpaste into the paint for a more realistic smell if you like.
Put the Black paint out and see if anybody gets the idea to use it to make cavities.

TOOTHPASTE

Make toothpaste. Mix 4 teaspoons baking soda, one teaspoon salt, and one teaspoon peppermint flavoring. Add just enough water to form thick paste.

SNACK

APPLE TEETH



Core and cut apple into 8 slices
Spread peanut butter on top of each slice of apple
Place marshmallow "teeth" on top of 4 of the slices, peanut butter
side up. Top with other apple slices, peanut butter side down.

FINGERPLAYS

And then again at night




LOST TOOTH POCKET


Cut out pocket. Fold on dotted lines. Tape child's tooth into the pocket so it won't go missing. Staple shut.



SUPER SMILE

Cut poster board to fit pattern. Fold in half to create mouths. Give each child a mouth, a pattern, scissors, glue, dental floss, and 20 miniature marshmallows. Have kids cut pattern and glue into mouth. Have kids glue a marshmallow on top of each tooth in the pattern and fold the cardboard to create mouthful of teeth. Let dry. Have them practice flossing.





SAD TOOTH - HAPPY TOOTH AND THE TOOTHBRUSH


Trace and cut patterns for child. Let them color in cavities on sad tooth! Write their names on the toothbrush. Punch hole in top of all three and string on thread. Put the toothbrush near the happy tooth!

TOOTH NUMBERS

Copy face pattern 5 times. Write numbers 1-5 on either neck or hair. Cut 15 small white squares (to resemble teeth). Children place proper number of teeth in mouth.
