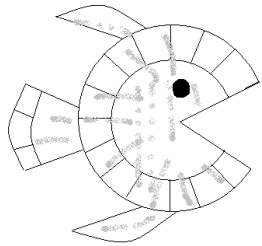


OCEANS / SEA SHELLS

ART

PAPER PLATE FISH

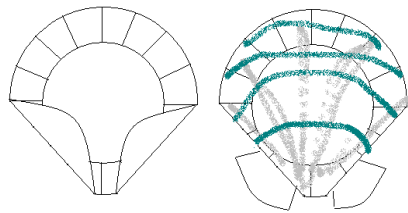


Material: 2 paper plates, scissors, stapler, markers, paint, glitter, glue

1. Cut out mouth
2. Staple the cutout piece onto the body for a tail.
3. Cut the top and bottom fins from 2nd plate and staple to body.
4. Decorate

SCALLOP SURPRISE

Material: 2 paper plates, stapler, scissors, paint

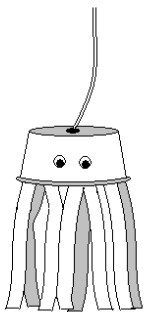


1. Fold sides of plate under to form point. Staple
2. Cut out 2 triangle pieces from 2nd plate. Staple to the point
3. Decorate

SEASHELL WIND CHIME

Tie several pieces of brightly colored yarn around a cardboard tube, a dowel, or a piece of driftwood, leaving one inch of space between each string. Tie three or four seashells on each string, positioning them so they will hit each other when they are blown in the wind. Glue the shells in place. Attach a string hanger to the tube and hang it outside where it will blow in the wind.

JELLYFISH



Material: foam bowl, wiggle eyes, tissue paper or iridescent cellophane, yarn, glue, blue paint

1. make a glue-water mixture and tint with the blue
2. paint the bowl
3. glue on wiggle eyes
4. cut several lengths of cellophane or tissue paper and glue to underside of bowl
5. punch hole in top of bowl and suspend from yarn

OCEAN IN A BAG

2 Ziplocks of the same size
Styrofoam trays in several colors
White plastic beads
blue hair gel
small seashells
clear packing tape

Fill one of the bags with blue hair gel so that when the bag is closed and flattened out the gel is about 1/4 to 1/2 inch thick all over the inside surface of the bag.

Cut 1 to 2 inch long fish from several different colored styrofoam trays. Put them in the bag. Toss in a few seashells and plastic beads for bubbles.

Squeeze as much air as possible out of the partially closed bag, then seal the bag. Place the bag, sealed end first, inside the other bag. Zip second bag closed. Cover the closed edge of the bag with clear tape.

Run hands over surface of bag to make fish move around.

SEASHELL PAPER WEIGHT

MATERIALS: Small seashells, sand, large tray, baby food jars with lids, colored adhesive tape, beach sand

Dry sand thoroughly. Scoop sand into jars until 3/4 full. Add several small shells into jar. Tape lids to bottles. Invert jar and shake to see different shells.

PAPER PLATE AQUARIUM COLLAGE

MATERIALS

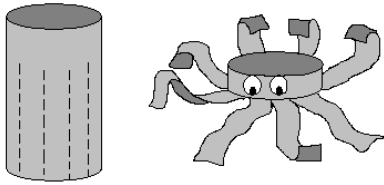
Fish pictures or stickers	2 9" paper plates
Scissors	glue
Blue or clear plastic wrap	Shell macaroni
Small pebbles or beans	scraps of yarn (green or brown)
Hole punch	crayons or colored markers

1. Cut one 6" circle from the center of one plate.
2. Glue a 7" x 7" piece of plastic wrap over the inside of the hole.
3. On other plate, glue collage materials in place to form ocean scenes.
4. Glue cut plate (with plastic "window") onto plate with collage.
5. Punch hole through both plates and tie on a 12" piece of yarn to hang.

SAND DRAWINGS

Dribble glue onto paper. Sift sand onto glue. Let dry.

CRAZY OCTOPUS



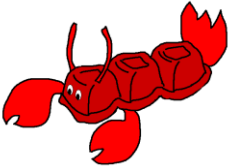
Materials: 1 toilet paper tube, scissors, crayons, wiggle eyes

1. Make 8 evenly-spaced cuts 2/3 of the way up the tube.
2. Bend and curl the 8 legs so they spread out.
3. Draw on face or glue on wiggle eyes.

OCTOPI

Use half a paper plate for octopus body. Use black crayons to draw eyes. Glue eight pieces of white crepe paper to the bottom edge of each octopus body to make arms. Hang octopi and watch them "swim" as air moves through the room.

ROCK LOBSTER



Use 3 cup section of a cardboard egg carton. Paint red. Cut out 3 claws and a tail and glue to cups. Attach 2 pipe cleaners for antennae and 2 wiggle eyes.

TUBE OCTOPUS

Material: Paper tube, 1.5"
3 pipe cleaners, pink
Purple paint
2 wiggly eyes
Hole punch
Tacky glue



1. Paint paper tube (inside and out) purple and set aside to dry.
2. Punch 8 holes around the bottom of the tube.
3. Cut the pipe cleaners in half.
4. Lace pipe cleaners from one side to the other. You will be using 4 pipe cleaners.
5. Wrap another pipe cleaner in the center where all the pipe cleaners cross and twist to secure.
6. Curl the legs.
7. Glue on wiggly eyes and add a mouth.

OTHER FUN STUFF

SHELL MATCHUP

Find several pairs of different types of shells.

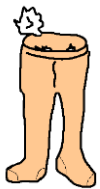
Place the shells in a clear container, such as a plastic food container or glass bowl. Let children take turns sorting through the shells, finding those that match, and setting the pairs out on a table.

CRAB WALK

Sit on the floor. Place hands behind you. Bend knees and keep your feet flat on the floor. Now lift your bottom off the floor. Try to keep your stomach flat. Crabs mostly move sideways, but they can also move forward and backward.

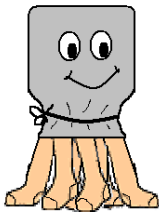
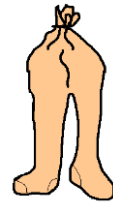
OCTOPUS

Materials: 1 pillowcase, 4 pairs of pantyhose, felt, newspaper, yarn



1. Cut eyes and mouth from felt and sew to pillowcase.

2. Stuff the pantyhose with crinkled-up newspaper



3. Tie the top of each pair of pantyhose closed with yarn.

4. Stuff the upper part of the pillowcase with paper.

5. Stuff the top of all 4 pair of pantyhose into the pillowcase. Secure with yarn.

(Variation: Sew Velcro to face. Make various expressions (sad, happy, etc.) for face. Let kids change the face)

And heard the ocean roar.

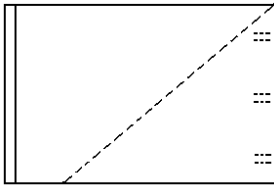
I found a tiny little shell,

SAILBOAT

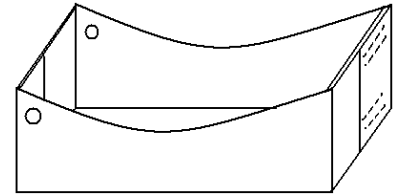
Materials: Appliance box, wooden dowel (6 feet long), white sheet, paint, masking tape, scissors



1. For the sail... Cut a white sheet into triangular shape slightly longer than the box. Cut 3 slits in the triangle for the dowel.

2. Lay the box on its side. Cut off one long side of the box. Cut a curve and a small hole on opposite sides of the box.

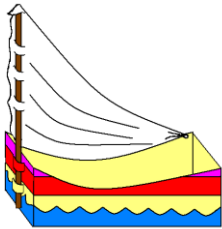
3. At the opposite end of the two small holes, cut 2 sets



of slits in one flap of the box. Insert the dowel through the slits. Tape the flaps on both ends of the box closed.

4. Paint the boat and dowel and let dry.

5. Thread the dowel through the slits of the sail. Tape the top of the sail to the dowel. Tie a piece of yarn to the other end of the sail and secure it through the hole at other end.



SUBMARINE

Use a Large cardboard box (refrigerator) on side. Cut out portholes in sides of box. Add a periscope using cracker boxes. Let children play inside.

WAVE MACHINE

Fill a small glass or plastic jar two-thirds full with water. Add a couple drops of blue food coloring and mix well. Then fill up the rest of the jar with mineral oil, getting rid of as many air bubbles as possible. Secure the lid. Let children hold the bottle sideways and gently tip it to create waves.

WAVE MACHINE 2

(For a demonstration ONLY... Materials are not suitable for children to handle.)

Use a large jar and 1 cup rubbing alcohol 1 cup turpentine mixture. Add a few drops of food coloring. This wave is extremely long-lasting and fairly impressive, but the materials should not be allowed into the hands of children.

GAMES

SCHOOL OF FISH

1. Mark a starting line and a finish line, opposite of one another about 10 feet apart.
2. Choose one child to be shark.
3. Remaining children are school of fish and line up behind the start line holding each other's waists.
4. At signal, school of fish tries to cross the finish line while shark tries to tag the last fish in line. The school of fish can sway or spiral to protect last fish.
5. If shark tags last fish, he continues playing shark. If school of fish crosses the finish line without getting caught, the head of the school of fish becomes the next shark, and the shark becomes the next tail.

FISH, FISH, SHARK

This game is based on the game duck, duck, goose. The children are in a circle and one child walks around tapping the other children on the head saying fish each time until they say shark one time. This child then runs around the circle chasing the other child to see who gets back to the empty space first.

UNDER THE SEA

MATERIALS: 1 twin sheet (preferably blue) precut pictures of sea animals (1 per child)

Put pictures on the floor and lay sheet on top. Ask each child to stand around edge and pick up sheet. Make waves by moving sheet up and down. While you are making waves, talk about what they may find in an ocean. Call one or two children at a time to "swim" under sheet and pick up a picture. When they surface, they should tell group what they found. If they cannot tell what it is, they can put it back or have group help. As pictures are identified, toss them on top of the sheet and let them bounce in the waves

PIN THE LEGS ON THE OCTOPUS

Play like Pin the Tail on the Donkey. (Basically, everyone wins!)

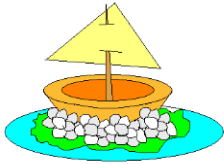
BEACH BALL FUN

1. Play Keep away.
2. Try to bounce the ball on your head without it touching the ground.
3. Have 2 children hold either end of a beach towel and bounce the ball on the towel.
4. Sit in a circle and roll the beach ball to each other

For the brave...try some sardines! For the not-so-brave hearted...Have tuna-fish salad.

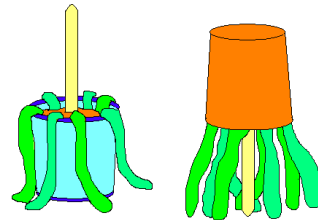
SAIL BOATS



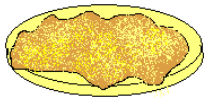
Wash a lettuce leaf and lay it on plate. Place half a peach or pear on the lettuce with round side down. Cut small piece of white cheese into triangle shape for sail. Stick toothpick through cheese for mast. Stick toothpick into peach. Add cottage cheese around peach.

OCTOPOP

In a dixie cup, pour juice (orange, apple, fruit punch, etc.), put in a craft stick. Put in gummy worms hanging over the edge to look like legs. When the pop is taken out of the cup it looks like an octopus on a stick.



SAND DOLLARS



Put peanut butter on round crackers. Sprinkle wheat germ or Parmesan cheese on peanut butter pretending it is sand.

OYSTER COOKIES

2 mini popcorn cakes
strawberry frosting
1 mini marshmallow



Spread frosting on one popcorn cake. Add a mini marshmallow for the "pearl." Use the 2nd popcorn cake as the top of the oyster. "Spread frosting on the top. Eat!"

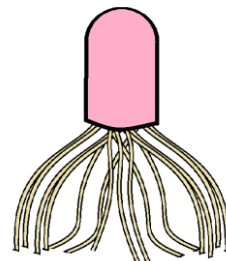
HOT DOG OCTOPUS

Leaving 1 inch at the top of each hot dog for the head, cut it lengthwise in eighths to create octopus legs. Boil the hotdog. The heat will curl the legs of the octopus. You can draw on features with ketchup.



HOT DOG SQUID

Insert uncooked spaghetti into 1/2 of a hot dog (also uncooked). Boil until spaghetti is done.



FINGERPLAYS

OCEAN SHELL

Friends building castles (place fists one on top of the other)
As high as they can (continue with fist movements)

I hold my arms out (stretch arms out at sides)
As far as they'll reach (stretch arms even wider)
Oh my, what fun (dance in place)
On this day at the beach (smile)

5 LITTLE SHELLS

(hold up 5 fingers and lower 1 at a time)

5 little shells lying on the shore,

SAILBOAT

And hold it in your hand (hold out hand)

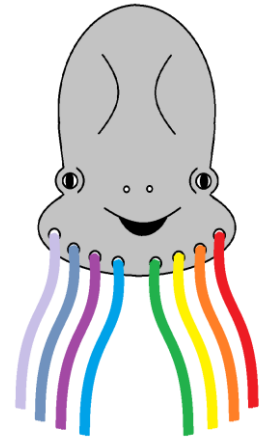
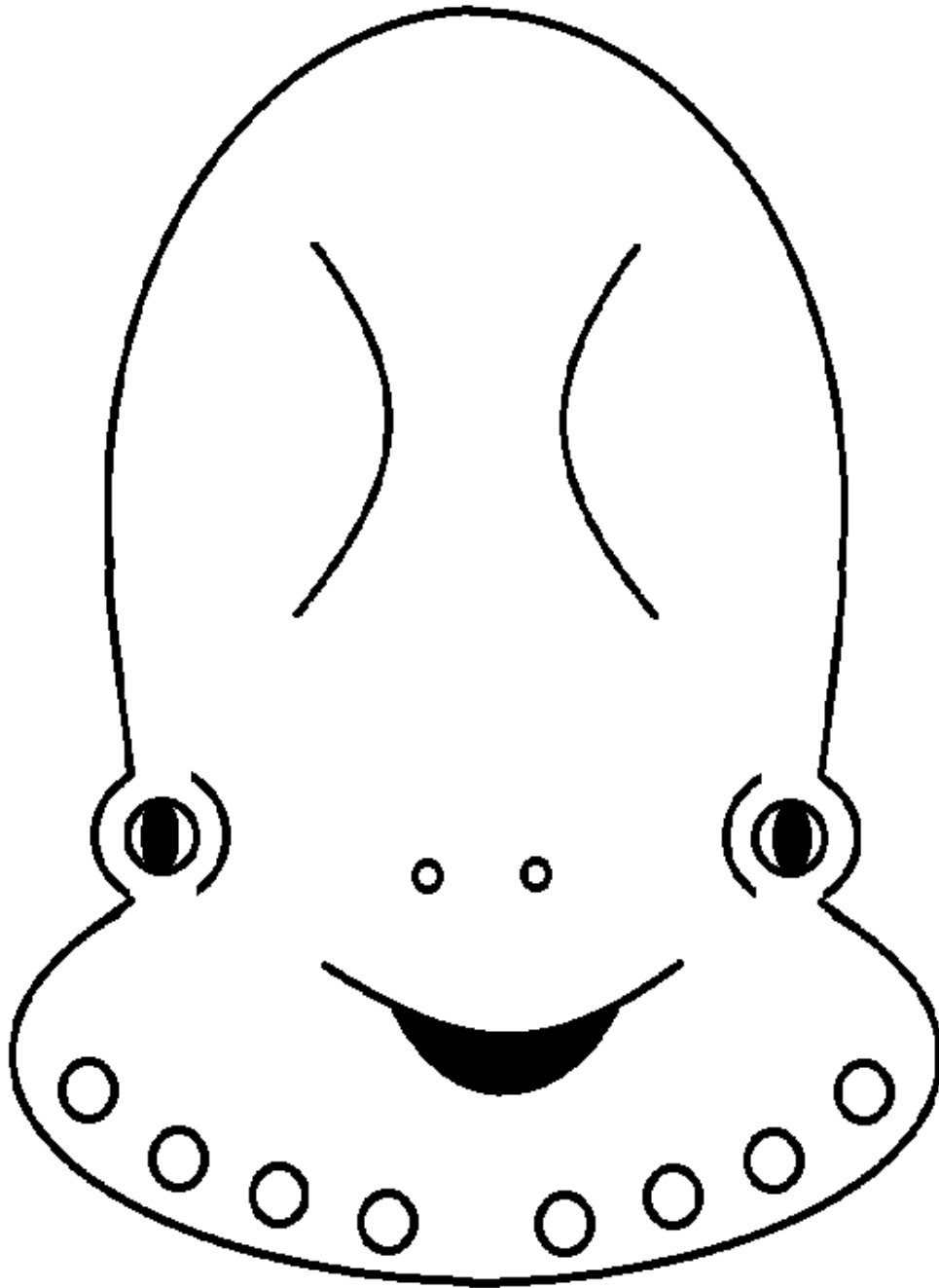
When you get the seashell home, (walk in place)

Hold it to your ear (hold hand to ear)

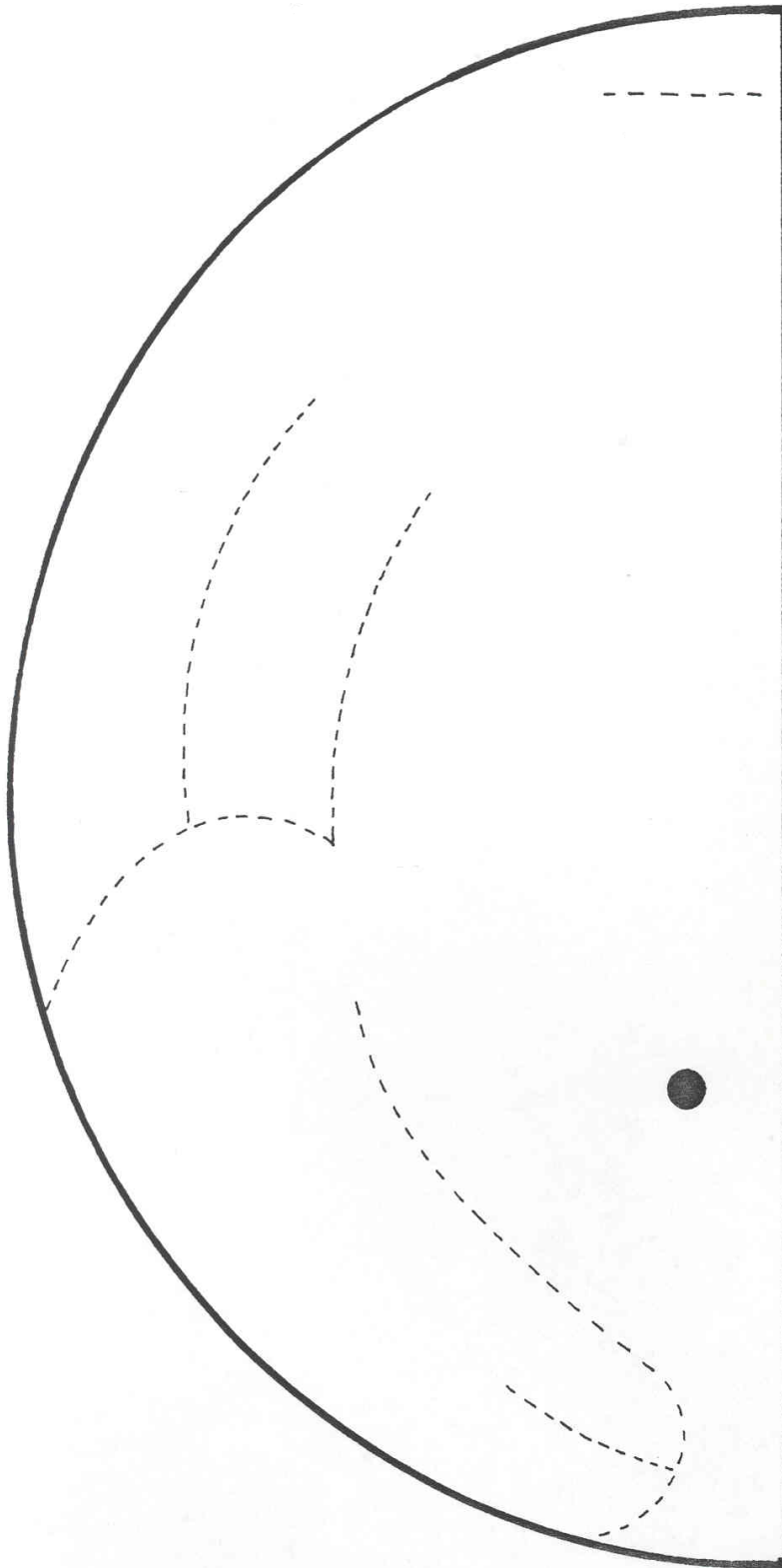
And listen very carefully, the ocean's what you'll hear! (cup hand around ear)

OCTOPUS

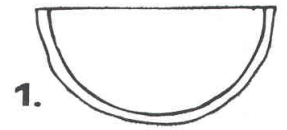
Cut and color pattern. Add yarn for legs.



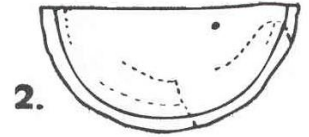
CRAB



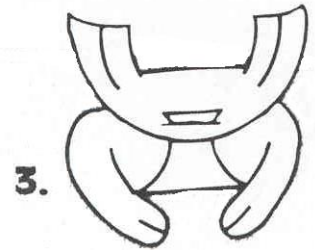
Fold plate in half.



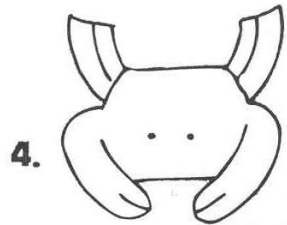
Cut on dotted lines
Unfold plate.



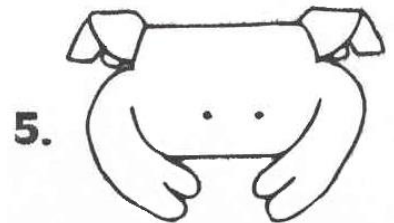
Turn crab over and stick the front tab through the back slot.



Turn crab over to front. Press down on the top of the crab to flatten it a bit. Bend the bottom half of the pincers back slightly.



Bend the hind legs back so that the bottoms jut out and rest on the ground.
