## ART

### NUMBER ART

In block letter style, put the outline of the numbers, 1-10 on a large piece of butcher paper. Have the children fill in the outlines with correct number of items. (For example, on the number 1 draw one circle each. On the number 2 draw 2 butterflies, etc.)

### NUMBER RUBBINGS



Cut numerals out of sandpaper and allow children to make crayon rubbings of them.

## OTHER FUN STUFF

### GROW A NUMBER

Pick a lucky number. Wet a sponge and set it in a shallow dish. Sprinkle cress seeds in the shape of the number on the sponge. Set the seeds in indirect sunlight. Take turns checking the sponge each day to keep it damp. Water dish, not sponge. (keep an eye on it and weed any that grow out of place)

### DRAWING NUMBERS

As you recite the poem, use the cues to draw numbers from 1-10.

Across the sky, then down from heaven; that's the way to make a seven.

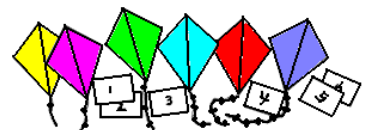
Make an S and don't be late, go back up and shut the gate. (8)

Make a hoop, add a line; that's the way to make a nine.

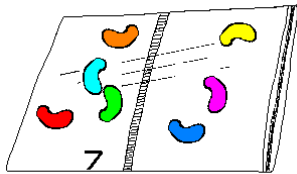
One is fun and zero the hero, make ten. And now my book comes to an end

### KITE COUNT

Make construction paper kites using different colors. Tie knots in tails. Make cards with numbers on them. Encourage children to match numeral cards to kites according to the number of knots tied in the tail of each kite.



### MATH NUMBER BUGS



1. Spray large beans desired colors with enamel paint; allow drying time. Spray the back of the beans. (This step is optional, plain lima beans can be used.)
2. When beans are completely dry, place the desired number of beans in a Ziploc bag and close it.
3. With a marker, write the number of beans on the bottom of the bag. Draw a vertical line down the middle of the bag.
4. Let children move the beans from one side to the other, leaving beans on either side of the bag. Help them to note that the total number of beans in the bag always remains the same. For example, if five beans are in the bag, children can manipulate the beans to see combinations that make five - two beans on one side of the vertical fine and three beans on the other side.

## SNACK

### SANDWICH FRACTIONS

Cut sandwiches into 2, 3, or 4 pieces. Have children count the number of pieces they have. Have the put the back together to see that they all have a whole sandwich.

## Make a Numeral Necklace

Reproduce this page and cut on the dotted line. Cut out the numeral boxes and assign each child a different numeral. Have children paste their numerals on oaktag and punch holes where indicated. Put yarn through each hole and tie to make a necklace. If you wish to play this

game with more than ten children, make two-digit numerals by pasting two boxes on a larger piece of oaktag. (Be sure children draw in small shapes and animals to total the correct number.) Older children may color their necklaces.

- Hey! Four (or any number) (starter)
- Someone's calling your name (all except 4)
- Hey! Four (all except 4)

Children should do motions together, following the rhythm of the song. The teacher will be the starter.

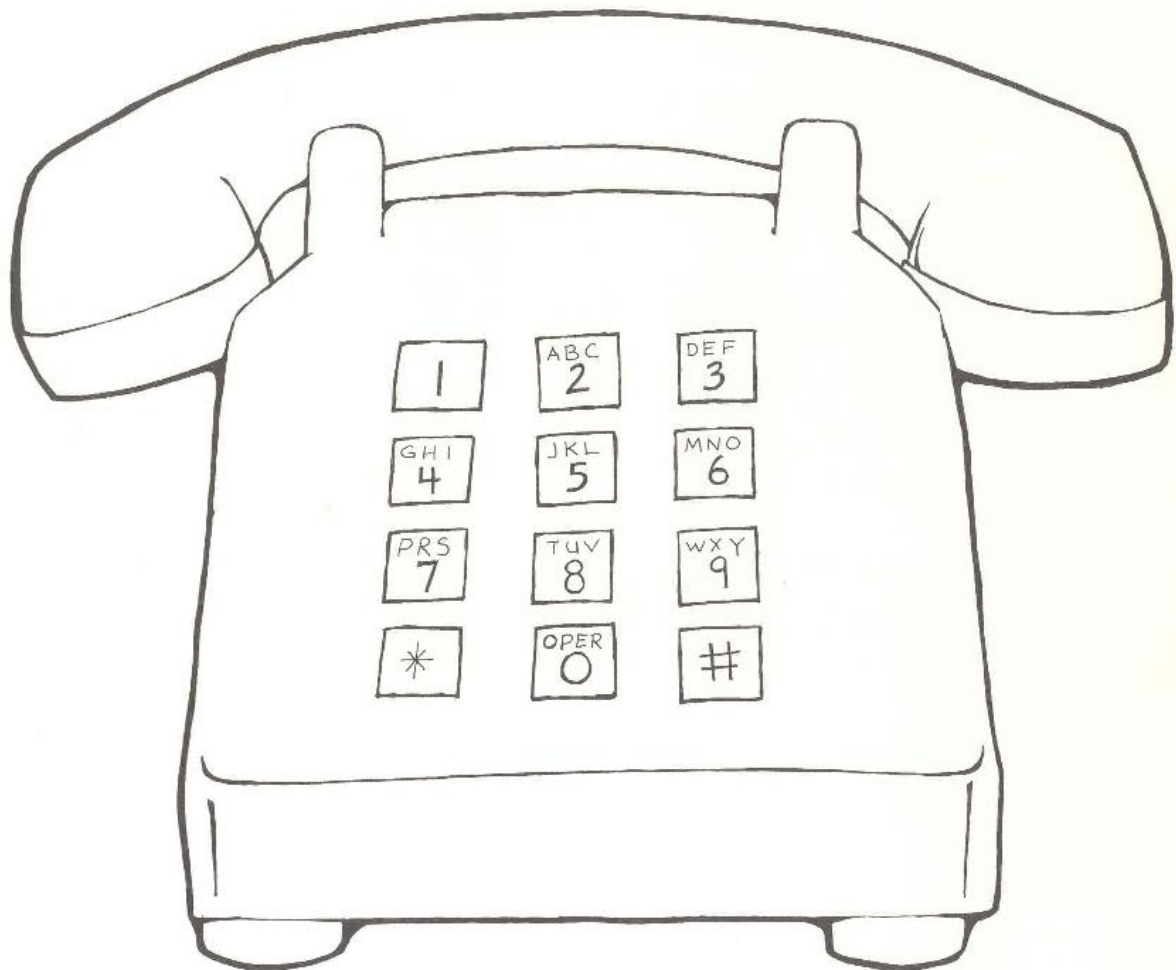

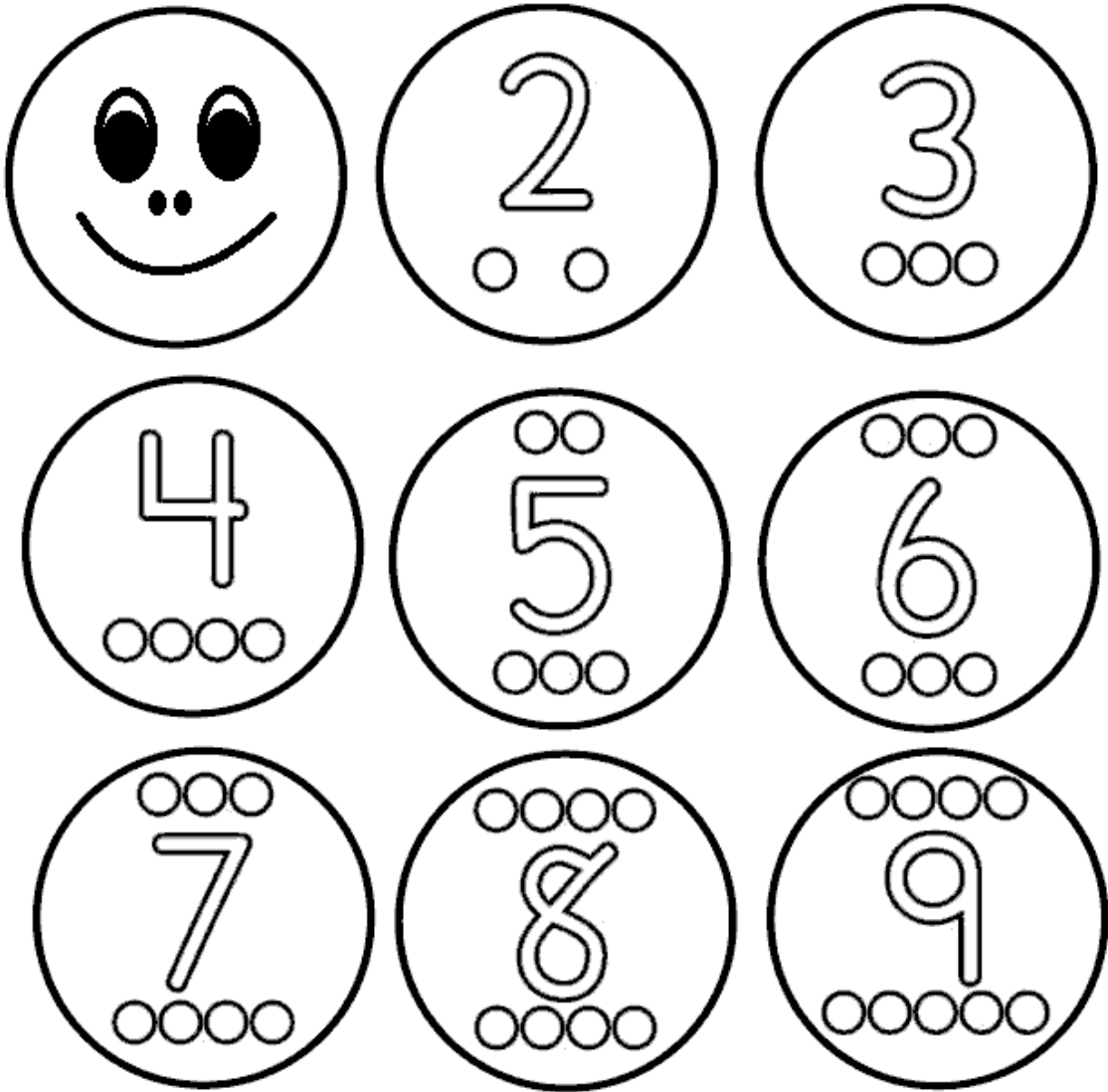
