## ART

### WHEAT PICTURES

Have children glue stalks of wheat onto paper.

### FRUIT MUFFINS

Cut large muffin shapes from tan paper. Set out shapes and several colors of inkpads (blue for blueberries, brown for raisins, red for cherries, etc.) Have kids press finger onto inkpads then onto muffin shapes to make fruit muffins. (If they don't want to get fingers inky, have them press eraser ends onto inkpads.)

### MINI BREAD MONSTERS



Material: store-bought bread dough, toothpicks, concentrated food coloring paste, scissors, garlic press, raisins, egg white, water

Pre-mix the food coloring and the dough to make a variety of colors. Divide colors among children. Allow children to create monsters. Let them cut, roll, squeeze, and play. After they are done, place monsters on cookie sheet and brush with egg/water mixture. Let rise. Bake and eat!

### PANCAKES

Have the children cut a pancake out of brown paper. Use a hole punch to punch blueberries out of blue paper. The children glue the berries onto the pancake in the shape of their first initial. Follow this by making real pancakes. Using an old squirt bottle filled with pancake batter, write and cook pancakes in the shape of their initials.

## SNACKS

Serve toast and jelly. Serve different types of bread from various countries.

Use canned biscuits to cook a tasty treat. Brush with butter and sprinkle with sugar and cinnamon.

Thin food color with water and paint bread slices. Pop into toaster for colorful fun!

## OTHER FUN STUFF

### **CHEF'S HAT**



Cut a poster board band 3" x 23"  
Staple into a circle.

Staple a white paper bag to ring to make a chef's hat.  
(Optional: instead of a bag, use a large circle of tissue paper,  
gathered and taped to ring.)

## MEASURING GRAIN

Place oats in a deep basin and add measuring cups of different sizes, teaspoons, Tablespoons, mixing bowls of different sizes, muffin tins, slotted spoons, funnels, cakes pans, etc. Allow the children to measure and fill containers. Ask questions such as "How many cupfuls does it take to fill this bowl?" and "How many spoonfuls does it take to fill this muffin cup?"

## BAKERY SHOP

Make doughnut shapes out of different colored poster board. Have one for each child. Place doughnuts on floor. Repeat verse while children pick out correct colored doughnut.

## WHO HAS THE BREAD

Bring four or five different types of bread to circle time in plastic bags. Hold up each type and have children call out what kind of bread it is.

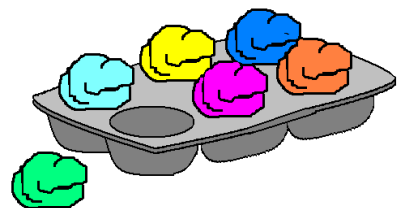
Have a child sit in the middle and cover his eyes. Give another child one type of bread and have him put it behind his back. All the other children put their hands behind their backs too. The child with the bread says, "The bagels are so good." After that, the child in the middle uncovers his eyes and tries to guess who has the bagels. As he guesses, he says, "Bryan has the bagels." That child says "Yes" or "No." Continue until the child in the middle guesses who has the bagels. The child with the bagels goes in the middle and covers his eyes and play continues.

## GRIND FLOUR

Use a hand grinder to turn wheat berries into flour (I bought some wheat berries at a Natural Food Market). It takes a lot of wheat berries and TIME to make enough flour for a recipe but it is fun!

## FILL THE MUFFIN TIN

Set out a six-cup muffin tin and six pairs of rolled-up socks for muffins. Let the kids take turns putting one "muffin" in each cup of the tin. Help them count the muffins as they put them in and take them out.



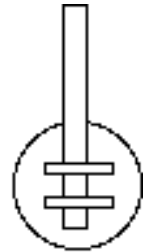
## LETTER FUN

Pour wheat or flour in cookie sheet and let children trace words with their fingers.

## GAMES

### PANCAKE FLIPPING CONTEST

- 1) Have students make "skillets" using a ruler duct-taped to the bottom of an aluminum pie plate. (See illustration.)
- 2) Have each student make a "pancake" at least 5 inches in diameter out of clay or modeling dough. You may also use a lid from a plastic container, or the plastic lid of a coffee can.
- 3) Students put their pancakes in their skillets and hold the skillets out in front of them by the ruler/handle at arm's length with one hand.
- 4) Say "Ready, Set, FLIP." Each time you say "FLIP," each student has to flip his or her pancake. The pancake must go at least one foot in the air and turn over completely for a flip to count. (For younger or less dexterous students, the pancake may simply go up and down without flipping.)
- 5) You may occasionally have long pauses between flips. It will become increasingly difficult for students to hold the skillets out in front of them.
- 6) When a student drops a pancake, he or she is removed from play.
- 7) Repeat until only one student remains as the winner.

Serve them to my friends and me!

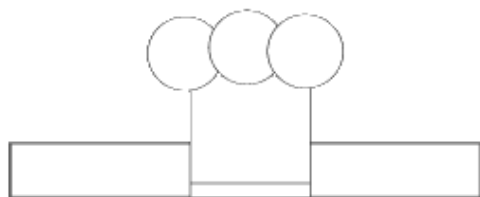
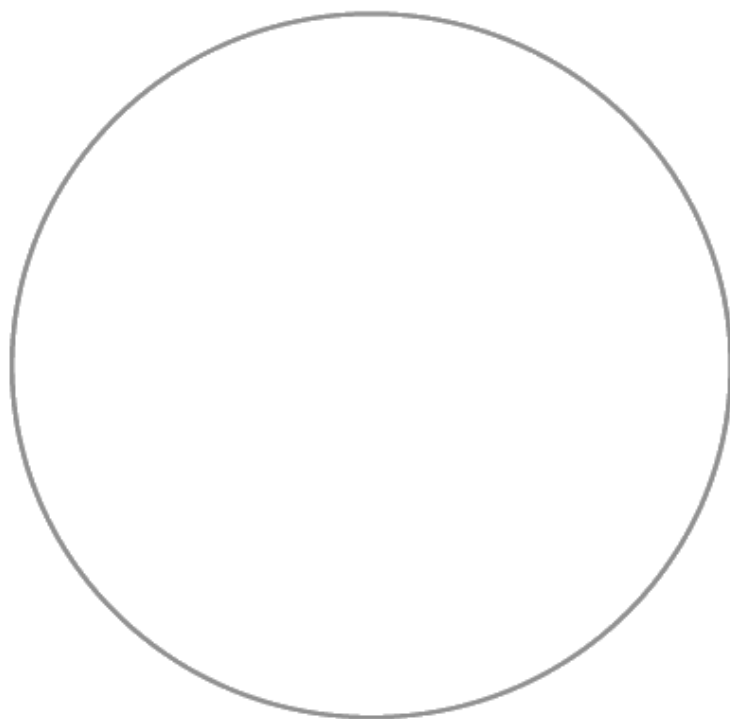
### THE DOUGHNUT

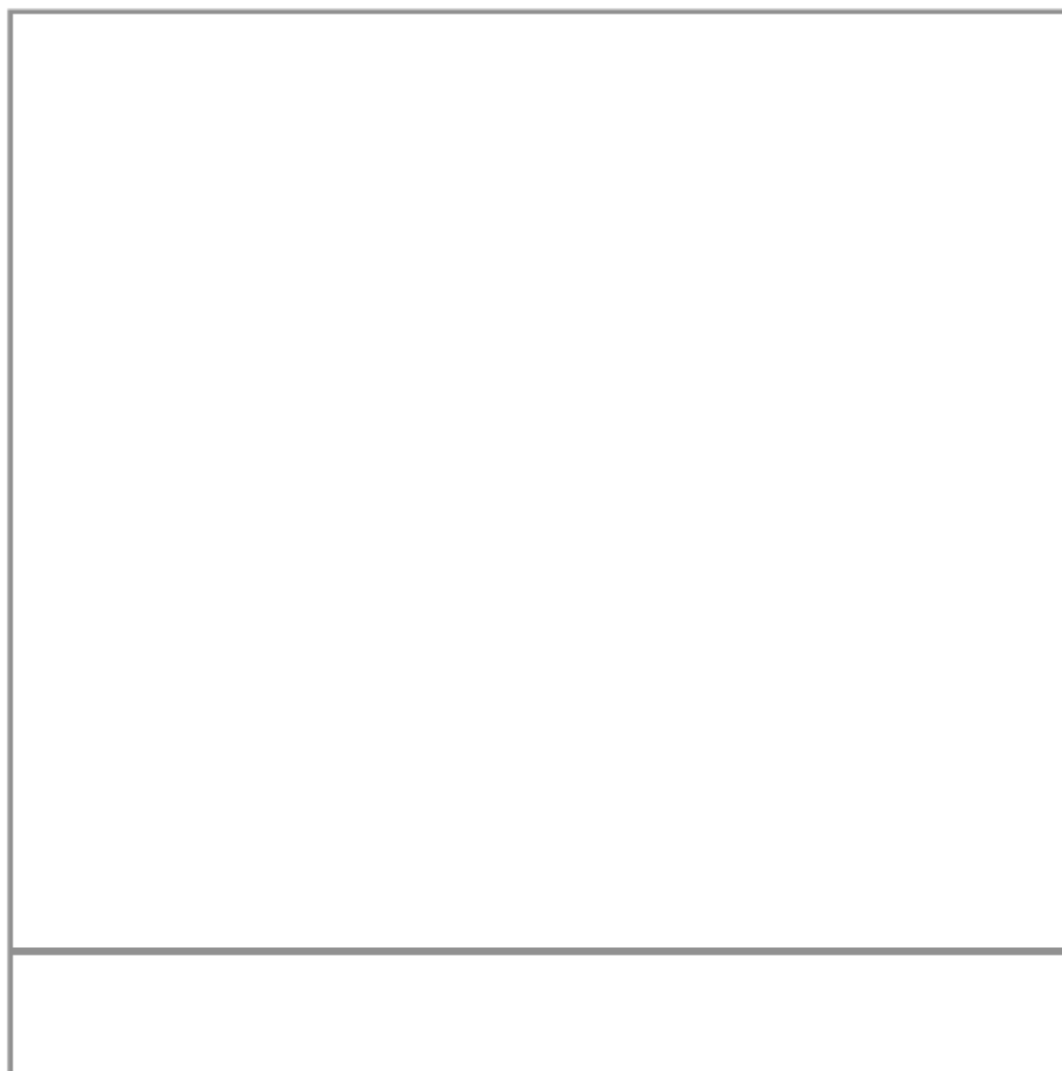

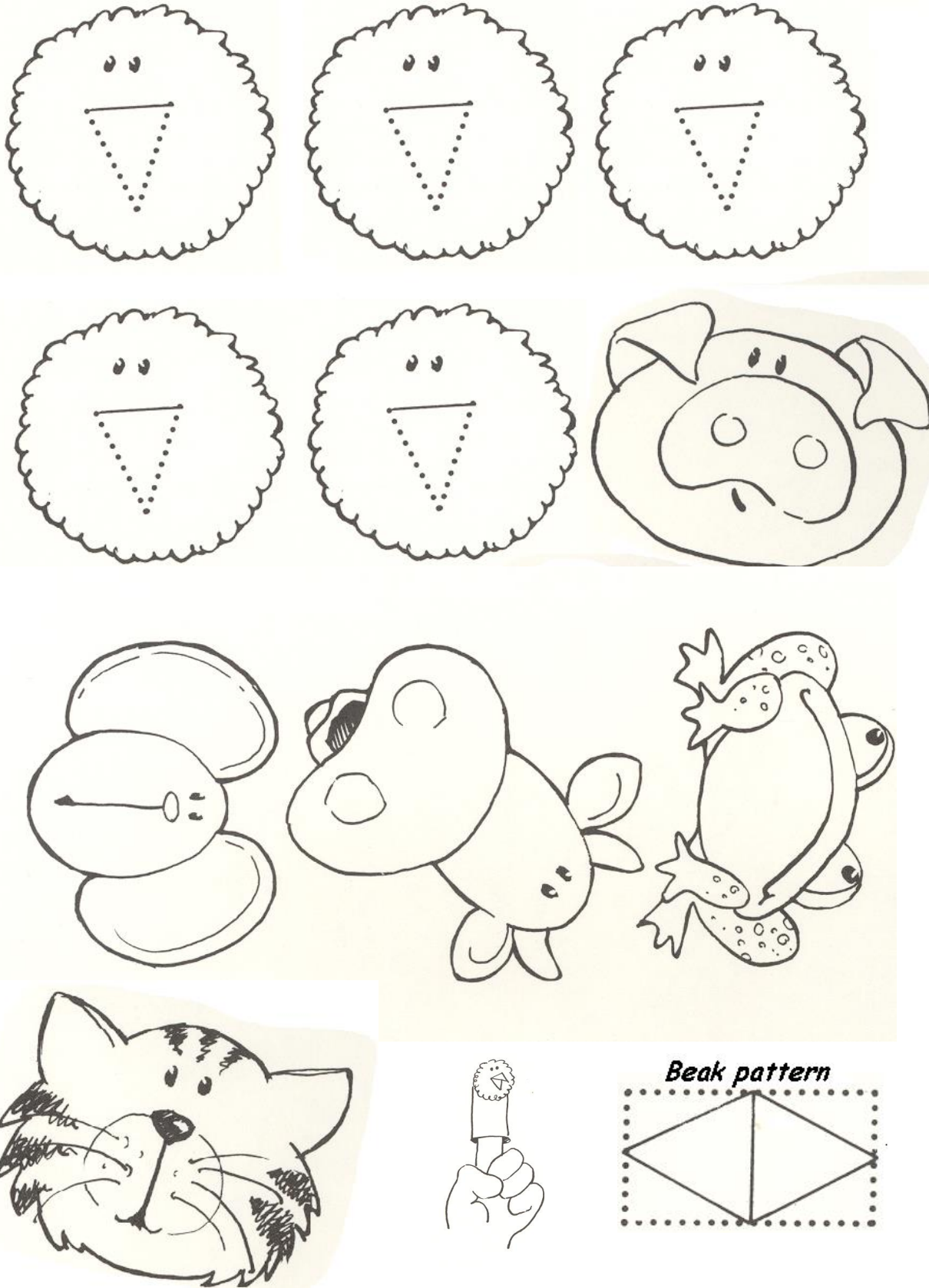
**Baker's Hat**

1. Cut two additional circles for each hat using the template.
2. Cut out one square template below
3. Overlap and glue circles (see illustration)
4. Shape practice: Identify the shapes
5. Number practice: Count pieces, how many circles?
6. Alphabet: Write letter B or the word Baker on the square portion of the hat.
7. Make a headband: Cut strips of paper 3 to 4 inches tall and tape together to make a band 22 to 24 inches long.
7. Glue the assembled hat to center of the band, adjust around child's head and tape.



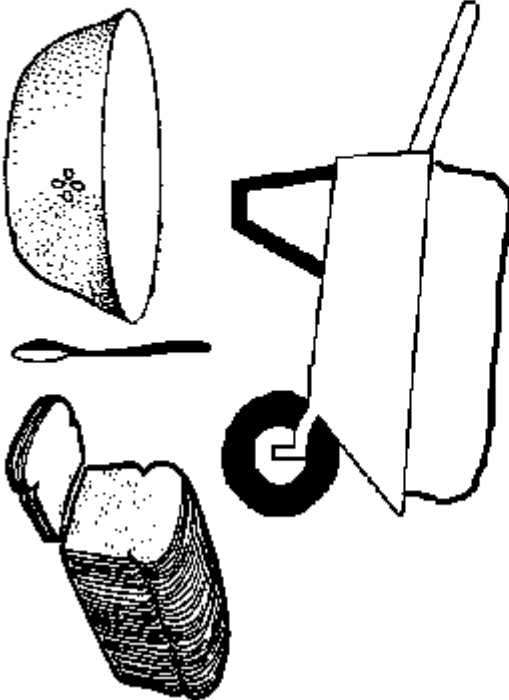
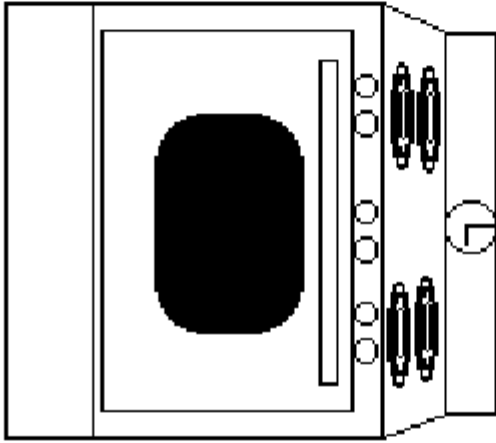
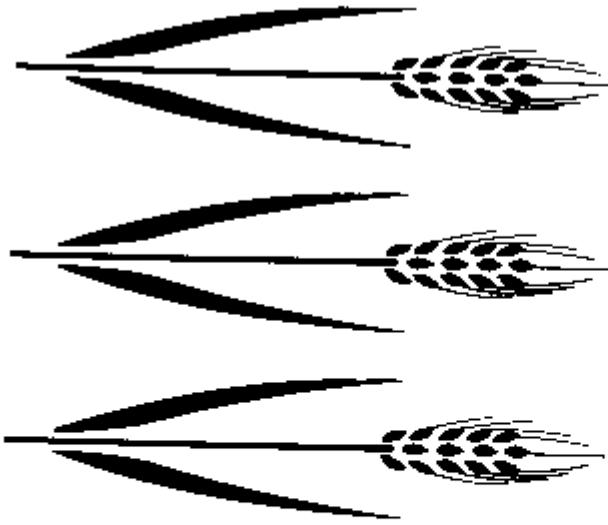
### LITTLE RED HEN FINGER PUPPETS

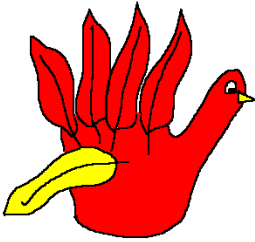
Copy patterns

## LITTLE RED HEN RECIPE HOLDER

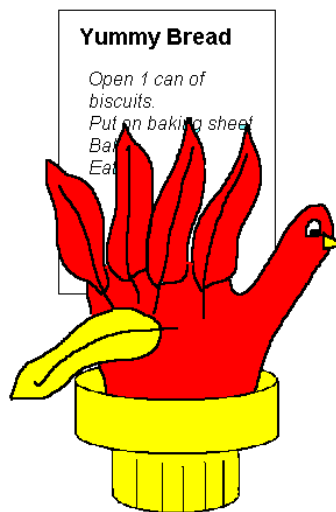
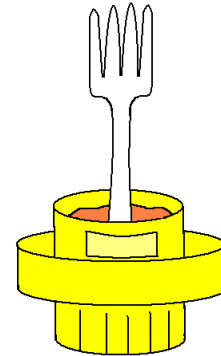
Material: glue, red and yellow felt, cardboard, pencil, scissors, google eye, 4 red feathers, 1 yellow feather, large plastic laundry soap lid, clay, plastic fork, masking tape.



1. Glue a piece of red felt larger than your hand to a piece of cardboard and let dry.
2. Trace hand onto felt and cut out. (This will be hen.)
3. Cut a triangle beak from yellow felt and glue on end of thumb. Glue google eye on thumb above beak.
4. Glue a red feather on each finger. Glue yellow feather sideways

across hand for wing.

5. Fill the inside of the plastic lid with clay. Stick the fork handle into the center of the clay. (The prongs will hold the recipe card.)
6. Put some masking tape across the side of the lid below the back side of the fork. (Will help with gluing.) Glue the hen to the tape, resting in the outer shelf portion of the lid.
7. Add a recipe for homemade bread and give for a gift!
