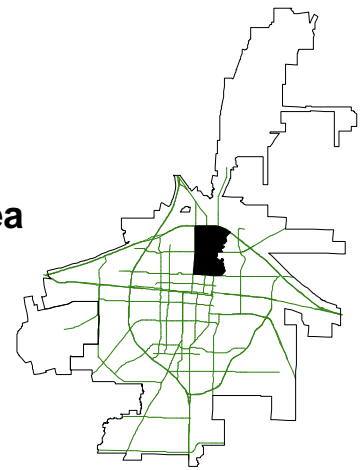


**Super Neighborhood

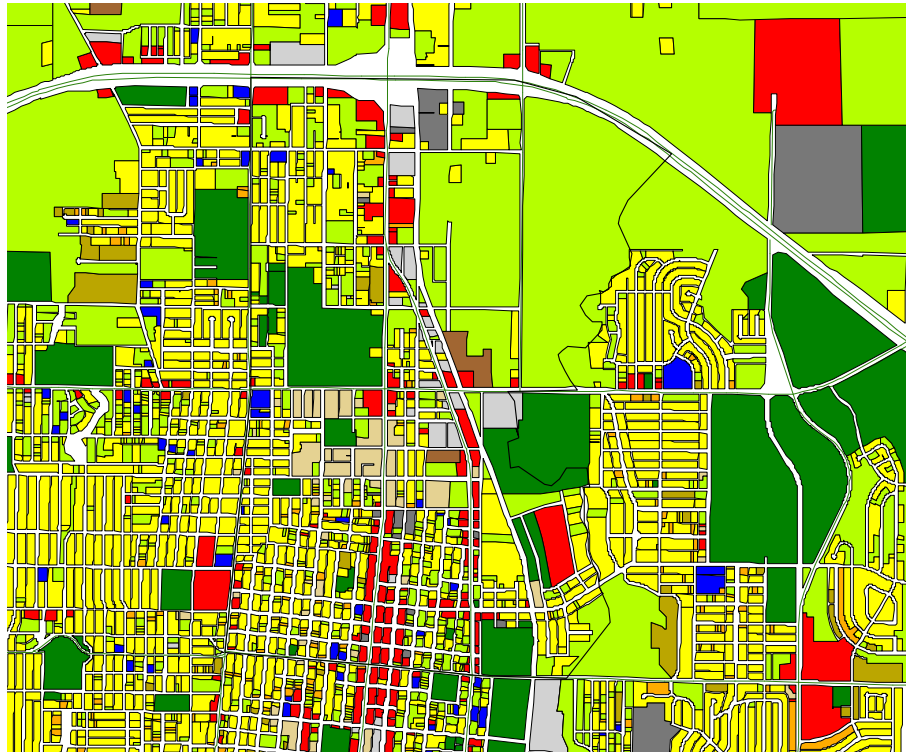
