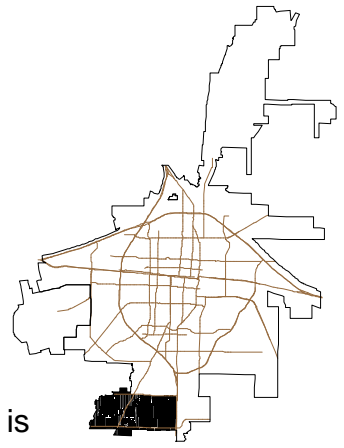


Super Neighborhood

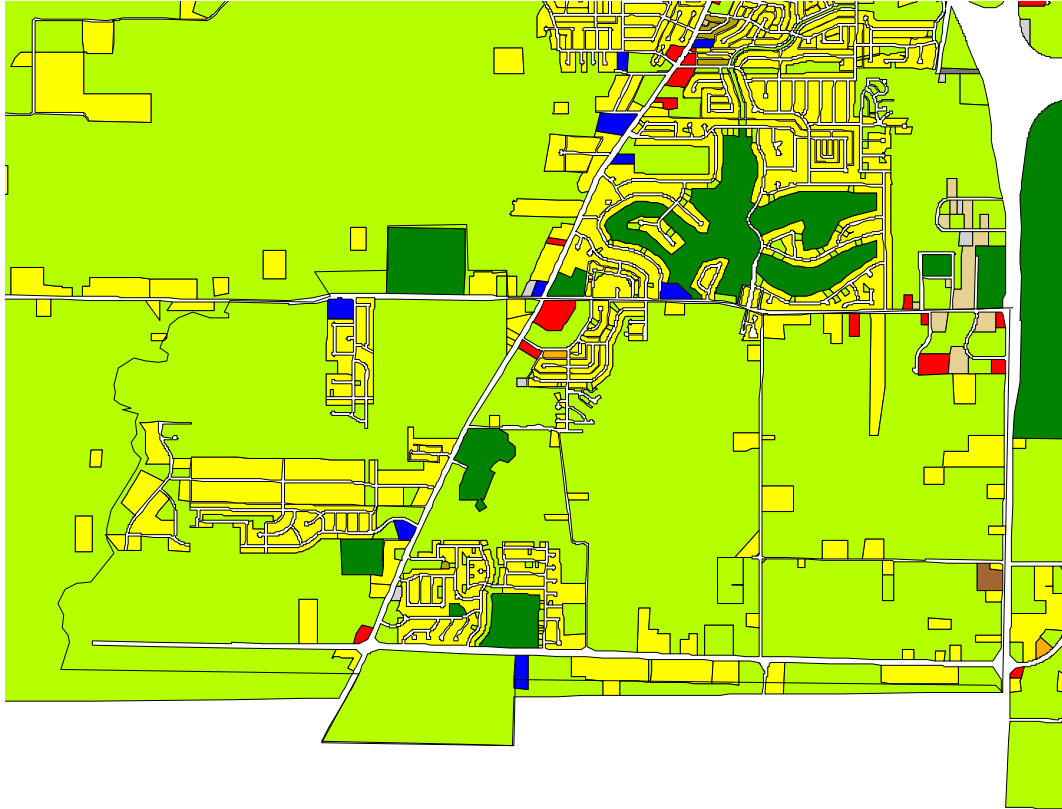
