Fraud Investigation

Members of the Fraud, Cyber Crimes, and Patrol divisions of the Abilene Police Department executed a search warrant in the 2700 block of S 11th on the 26th of April, 2018 after a forgery investigation involving numerous subjects.

This investigation has resulted in the arrest of 5 people, and the recovery of illegal narcotics and stolen checks. Charges on additional suspects will be forthcoming.

Arrested parties include:

- Ashley Alaniz arrested for SF Forgery of a Financial Instrument, as well as a warrant for Issuance of a Bad check CM.
- Daniel Symonds arrested for AM Fail to ID, as well as six outstanding warrants from Taylor and Eastland counties.
- Jason Brannon arrested for SF Possession of Methamphetamine.
- Kellie Akins arrested for SF Possession of Methamphetamine.
- Amanda Milsap arrested for SF Possession of Methamphetamine.

Detectives with the Fraud division have been investigating multiple cases of forgery that culminated in the execution of this search warrant at a residence in the 2700 block of S 11th Street.
