Teahoga Glover Shooting Investigation Update

ABILENE, TX – Often in the immediate aftermath of a tragic event such as the death of Mr. Glover, incorrect information and rumor find their way onto social media. Today, we learned there are members of our community that believe Teahoga Glover was shot twice. That is incorrect.

The investigation conducted by APD's Criminal Investigation Division revealed Teahoga Glover was shot only once. Today, confirmation of that assessment was received in the form of the preliminary autopsy report from the Tarrant County Medical Examiner's Office. That report clearly states Mr. Glover sustained one gunshot wound.

Prior to this release, APD spoke directly with Mr. Glover's family in an effort to ensure they were in possession of the accurate information regarding this topic before anything was released to the public.

As this investigation is ongoing, we will not be commenting further on the specifics of this case. We urge our citizens to rely upon factual information that comes from the Abilene Police Department regarding criminal cases.
