One Person In Custody After Man Killed in North Abilene Shooting

ABILENE, TX – Abilene Police Detectives have arrested 32 yr. old Willie Pruitt and charged him with 2nd Degree Felony Manslaughter in connection to the shooting death of Teahoga Glover, both of Abilene.

On Thursday, July 27, 2017, at approximately 3:08 a.m. Dispatch received a call of an injured subject, possible shooting victim, at a home located on the 1900 block of Swenson in north Abilene. Police arrived on the scene to find a male victim, later identified as Teahoga Glover, in the process of being transported to the hospital by a private auto with what appeared to be a gunshot injury to his chest. The vehicle was escorted to a local hospital where Mr. Glover later died from his injuries.

Officers secured the scene of the crime and began an investigation and processing of the scene. Through the investigation, Willie Pruitt was identified as the suspect. He was subsequently brought to the Law Enforcement Center and charged with 2nd Degree Felony Manslaughter.
