Body of Female Discovered at Lake in Callahan County

ABILENE, TX – On January 27th, shortly after 1 p.m., the Abilene Police Department was notified that a female body had been discovered near Baird Lake. CID Detectives who had been working the missing person investigation responded to the area and requested the assistance of the Texas Rangers, since the venue was outside of the city limits. A deceased female has been recovered from near the lake, and the family of the missing person has been notified of that fact only. The positive identification of the body must be done by a medical examiner, which we expect will occur on Saturday, January 28th. Until then, the Department will continue to investigate the missing person report in addition to assisting the Rangers with the deceased body that was found.
