EX-SUPERINTENDENT ARREST

ABILENE, TX – The Police Department is aware of Dr. Heath Burns' surrender to authorities today. The Department of Public Safety completed an independent, thorough investigation that resulted in Dr. Burns being arrested for 3rd Degree Felony Prescription Fraud. He has already bonded out of the Taylor County Jail on a \$5,000 bond.

The Police Department's investigation of Dr. Burns continues and contains several possible charges including misdemeanor and felony allegations. This investigation will likely be completed in the coming weeks and presented to the District Attorney for consideration of charges.
