Funeral Arrangements for Officer Allen will be held tomorrow, September 4th at 10:00 am at Beltway Park Church located at 4009 Beltway South in Abilene. Graveside will follow at the Clyde Cemetery in Clyde, Texas.

Visitation will be held this evening from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Beltway Park Church.

The procession will travel east on FM 707 from Beltway Park Church to FM 1750. Then north on FM 1750 to E.S. 11th. It will then proceed east on E.S. 11th to FM 18 and then east on FM 18 to Clyde. Once in Clyde the procession will turn south on Hunt Street and proceed to the cemetery. DPS and the Taylor County Sheriff's Office will be handling traffic direction within the city limits of Abilene. Clyde PD will take over in the city limits of Clyde. We encourage citizens to line the route in a show of support if they so choose. Please be cautious about where you stand and park as to not place yourself in danger.
