ABILENE, Texas - In order to improve conditions at the Nelson Pond, the City of Abilene is partnering with Texas Parks and Wildlife and Big Country Master Naturalist volunteers to implement a relocation and adoption program for the domesticated waterfowl. TPWD staff along with Master Naturalist volunteers have relocated several of these waterfowl to the City's Animal Shelter. These birds are now available for adoption on a first come first serve basis for \$3 an animal.
