Industrial Blvd. Improvements to Begin

ABILENE, Texas – The City of Abilene Public Works Department has contracted for roadway resurfacing improvements for Industrial Blvd beginning the evening of Sunday, October 7, 2018. These improvements are associated with Proposition 1 of the 2015 Bond Program.

The City of Abilene and the contractor, J.H. Strain & Sons, both recognize the traffic volume that this roadway serves. Therefore, the City and the contractor will pursue nighttime construction as long as temperatures meet city construction standards. Work will continue on a daily basis beginning at approximately 7 p.m. each night and concluding at 7 a.m. the next morning. If daytime operations become necessary, the work will shift to a 12-hour period between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

The project was designed to repave the Industrial Blvd. from the intersection of Industrial Blvd. and S. Danville Drive to Maple Street. This construction should be completed within the next 6 to 8 weeks weather permitting. Please remember to drive through all construction zones safely at all times for your and our workers safety.
